

ARCC Net Script

QST, QST, QST....Attention all Amateurs on frequency!

This is **NV7CC**, Net Control Station for the ARCC NET.

This net meets at 1900 hours local time every Sunday on the Lahontan Peak repeater 146.97 with a PL of 103.5 Hz., the KE6QK-R Echolink Node 976049, or on other repeaters or simplex as directed by net control.

All licensed HAMs within earshot are cordially invited to participate in tonight's get-together.

The purpose of this net is to pass message traffic, ARCC information, ARES information, and finally discuss items of general Amateur Radio interest.

Break to let the repeater reset

This is a directed net and stations are to direct all requests to net control. Stations with emergency or priority traffic may break the net at any time.

This is "**Call**", your Net Control Operator for tonight. My name is "**Name**".

Is there any message traffic?

Handle any message traffic.

Are there any **Club Announcements** from our Secretary/Treasurer (**Steve-KM6YU**), Vice President (**Rick-K7ET**), or President (**Brenda-AF7SW**)? (If they're here please come now)

Are there any **ARES Announcements** from our Emergency Coordinator (**Bob-KF7LSM**)?

Ask for check ins:

(Ask for mobiles or people with limited time. Ask for Echolink check ins. Then ask for local check ins.) (Take 3 or 4 calls and ask for comments until done).

Before closing the ARCC Net, are there any final check ins, or any final thoughts?
